## Grants

Over the last twelve months, Rugby Portobello Trust has issued nearly 3,000 individual grants totalling more than £16 million to 540 people.

These funds, donated by the public, were collected by multiple organisations and passed onto RPT for distribution to Grenfell residents.

Most of the funds have been distributed to former Grenfell Tower and Grenfell Walk residents, with £1,755,000 distributed to Lancaster West Estate residents who were without gas and water for weeks after the fire.

Further grants were available through other organisations, for example the grants distributed by The British Red Cross to support families who lost someone in the fire or residents who were hospitalised after the fire. In total, nearly £25 million has been made available to those affected by the fire.

The remaining balance of **£94,121.36** currently held by RPT is allocated to residents who have yet to claim all of their grants due to difficult circumstances.
