## Grenfell Tower funds and distribution

We have distributed **£ 10,956,865** to individuals and families affected by the Grenfell Tower Fire

For transparency all funds received and distributed by RPT during this terrible tragedy are shown below. For data protection reasons we are not able to comment on individual cases or provide any identifying information for individuals.

### Donations Received by RPT

We asked people to donate to survivors through The K&C Foundation; most people did this, however we received **£192,075** directly from the public for survivors

This includes donations from [Cadogan Hall](#), [Gospel for Grenfell](#), [Humanity First](#) and others.

This was allocated as follows:

- **£118,116** donated to fund cash payments in the early days after the fire.
- **£60,447** donated has been distributed to residents recently with the balance of **£13,512** to be distributed in a further grant round by early December

### Future Grants

Further donations including Art for Grenfell will be distributed in November once we have received the funds from Sotheby's. We expect this to be more than **£1.9million**.

### Funding for RPT from Donors:

**£154,221** has been donated to fund RPT services in our community.
